### General Information

1. Agricultural/Residential Zoned Lands – electrical connections can be authorised through the Planning Department for **irrigation purposes** without the applicant having to obtain Planning permission. If there are any buildings on the site other than a “pump house” Planning permission will be required.
2. All Non-Agricultural/Residential Zoned Lands – applications fall generally into two categories, namely:-
  - a. Agricultural purposes for **cultivation only** – this would follow the same process as 1 above. If crops are to be sold from the site(s) then other requirements will become necessary.
  - b. Agricultural purposes for **rearing livestock** – because of the potential violation of Regulation 9 (5) of the Development and Planning Regulations (2006 Revision), applications relating to this use shall be submitted to the Central Planning Authority for approval.

### Requirements for Approval

3. Provide one copy of Farmer’s identification or approval letter from the Department of Agricultural.

### Provide two (2) copies of the following.

4. **Site plan showing the following:**
  - a. Block and parcel information
  - b. Structure(s) on the site – indicate if the structure(s) is existing or new and if existing, indicate how long it has existed. All structures other than a pump house requires Planning permission
  - c. location of CUC pole
5. **Electrical information:**
  - a. How electrical service equipment will be supported (see **Electrical Service Support Requirements** page).
  - b. Riser diagram
  - c. Load calculation
  - d. Panel schedule
  - e. Circuit identification
  - f. Legend

All of the above information should be attached to an Agriculture Permit application in the Online Planning System (<https://www.planning.ky/ops/>)
